BAND FEE

The band fee of \$175 covers shared costs throughout the band year for various clinics and band ensemble supplies. Paymens (Card/Cash/Checks made payable to PHS Band OR PHS Guard) will be accepted at **band registration on 5/20 and 5/21**. You will have the option to pay in full or make two half payments. All band fees must be paid in full by the first day of summer band, **July 22nd, 2024** to ensure a spot in the competition show.





1. Due to a change in the application process, we will send an updated version of how to apply through email and our reminder app. We will get this out to all parents as quickly as possible.






REMIND SETUP INSTRUCTIONS



PORTER HIGH SCHOOL BAND PARENT/STUDENT UIL MARCHING BAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

No student may be required to attend practice for marching band for more than eight hours of rehearsal outside the academic school day per calendar week (Sunday through Saturday). This provision applies to students in all components of the marching band.

On performance days (football games, competitions and other public performances) bands may hold up to one additional hour of warm-up and practice beyond the scheduled warm-up time at the performance site. Multiple performances on the same day do not allow for additional practice and/or warm-up time.

Examples of Activities Subject to The UIL Marching Band Eight Hour Rule.

- Marching Band Rehearsal (Both Full Band and Components)
- Any Marching Band Group Instructional Activity
- Breaks
- Announcements
- Debriefing and Viewing Marching Band Videos
- Playing Off Marching Band Music
- Marching Band Sectionals (Both Director and Student Led)
- Clinics for The Marching Band or Any of Its Components

The Following Activities Are Not Included in The Eight Hour Time Allotment:

- Travel Time to and from rehearsals and/or performances
- Rehearsal Set-Up Time
- Pep Rallies, Parades and Other Public Performances
- Instruction and Practice for Music Activities Other Than Marching Band and Its Components


